What is Title I?

Citrus Springs Elementary is identified as a Title I school as part of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title 1 is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. All Title 1

schools must jointly develop with parents and family members a written parent and family engagement policy.

Title I Literacy Night Event – November 2020


Our literacy night event address student achievement, state standards, curriculum, strategies for parents, and information about state and local testing.

Barriers

Participation at Parent and Family Engagement events was hindered during the 2019-2020 school year due to COVID 19. Many events had to be canceled due to the pandemic. In response to this barrier, during the 20-21 school year, schools will offer their normally scheduled activities virtually in the event social distancing cannot be accommodated. Schools will provide needed assistance to families with students of disabilities, limited English proficiency and parents/families of migratory children.

The focus for reading is: 45% of SWD will make learning gains in ELA as measured by FSA Reading.

The focus for math is: 55% of SWD will make learning gains in math as measured by FSA Math.

School Plan for Shared Student Achievement

What is it?

This is a plan that describes how Citrus Springs Elementary will provide opportunities to improve family engagement to help support student learning. For each child we are committed to creating an environment that nurtures a lifelong desire to learn. Through teamwork with parents and our community, we will build a foundation of academic knowledge and skills, for students to become motivated learners and successful members of society. We will provide a continuum of learning experiences that are focused on the needs of the students.

How is it revised?

Citrus Springs Elementary invites all parents to attend our annual SAC Meetings to review and revise this parent and family engagement policy, the schoolwide improvement plan, our school-parent compact, and the family engagement budget. Additionally, parent input and comments regarding this plan are welcome during the school year. The plan is posted on our school website for parents to view and submit feedback throughout the year. All parent feedback received during the year will be used to revise the plan for the next school year. We also distribute an annual survey online to ask parents for their suggestions on the plan and the use of funds for family engagement. Parents and family members can also give feedback during parent meetings and other activities during the school year.

Who is it for?

All students participating in the Title I, Part A program, and their families are encouraged and invited to fully participate in the opportunities described in this plan. Citrus Springs Elementary will provide the opportunity for the participation of parents and family members with limited English language, disabilities, and migratory children.

Where is it available?

At the beginning of the year, the plan will be emailed to all parents. The Parent and Family Engagement Plan is posted on the school website. Parents can request a copy of the plan from their child's school.

Curriculum

Parents can contact teachers throughout the year to access grade level standards, as well as core and supplemental curriculum. Title I Literacy Nights will address student achievement, standards, curriculum, and state and local assessments. At Teacher-Parent Conferences held in September, teachers will address the individual needs of students with parents, by providing up-to-date data reports and addressing mastery of grade level standards.



Parent and Family Engagement



Citrus Springs Elementary is Branching Out!

Citrus Springs Elementary will take the following measures to promote and support parents and family members as an important foundation of the school in order to strengthen the school and reach our school goals. We will:

- ✓ Ensure all information related to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities is available in both English and Spanish and posted on the school website. Skyward, School Messenger, event flyers and social media are also used for parent communication, in addition to the monthly school newsletter for all families.
